

Origami Chick

Here is another cute model for your collection - you can just imagine this little chick cheeping, can't you?

The positioning of the folds in this model take a little bit of care, and might frustrate the youngest kids.



1. Start with your square colored side up. Fold in half diagonally, and crease carefully.



2. Unfold.



3. Now fold the square in half along the other diagonal, and crease again.



4. Unfold again and, with the colored side still facing up, fold the bottom corner up to touch the center.



5. Now fold the top point down until it meets the centre point, as shown.



6. Unfold again.



7. Fold the bottom point up to reach the lowest crease mark, as shown. Then make a fold along the dotted line ..



8. to look like this.



9. Do the same on the other side.



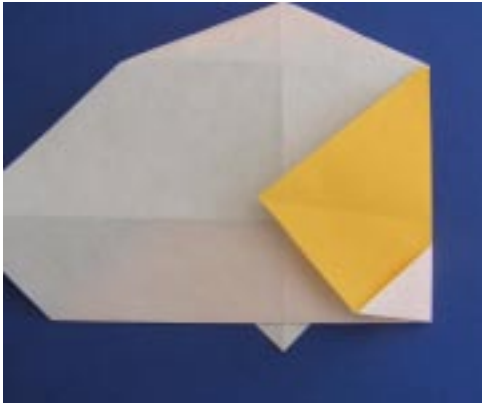
10. Rotate your model so that those folds are at the top. Now take the bottom corner and fold it up as shown in the photo above...



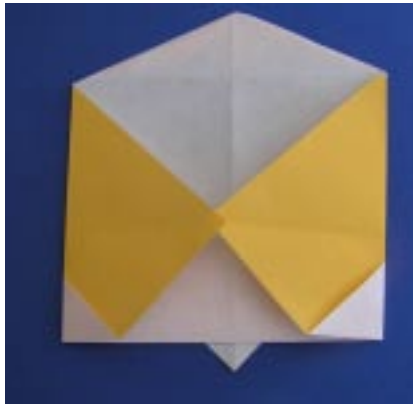
11. and then fold it back down again, lining up with the half-way crease, to form the beak.



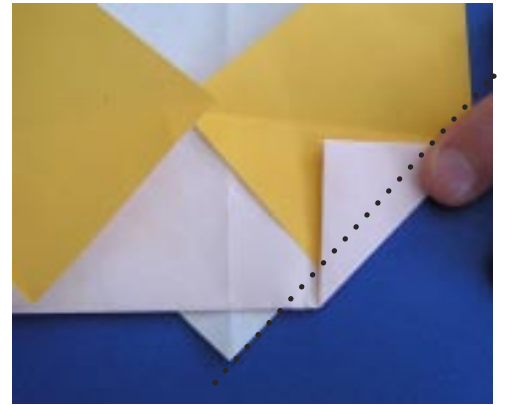
12. Flip over.



13. Fold the edge in towards - and a little beyond - the middle crease. Crease well.



14. Do the same on the other side.



15. Now turn the bottom corners in as shown. Be careful to fold them parallel to, but a little distance from, the angle of the beak.



16. This is the same fold, shown from the front of the model. Notice that you are left with a small section of white along the edge of the beak.



17. Do the same to the other side, and your model is ready for its features.



18. Our chick is a little cross-eyed!
