In 1928, Mustafa Kemal Atatürk introduced the Latin alphabet in Türkiye to make it easier to read and write. Today, it is still used in Türkiye and many other Turkish-speaking countries.

Remziye Hisar was born in Skopje, Macedonia in 1902. She was one of Türkiye's first female chemists and one of Marie Curie's students. Remziye Hisar studied at İstanbul University. She earned a PhD in chemistry from Sorbonne University in Paris. She contributed greatly to the development of chemistry in Türkiye. She received several awards during her career, including the Order of Academic Palms in 1955 from France and the TÜBİTAK Service Award in 1991. She died in İstanbul in 1992.


