A. Normally, falling oil prices would boost global growth. This time, though, matters are less clear cut.

B. If the source of weakness is financial , then cheaper oil may not boost growth all that much: consumers may simply use the gains to pay down their debts.

C. On the other hand, if plentiful supply is driving prices down, that is potentially better news: cheaper oil should eventually boost spending in the world's biggest economies.

D. The big economic question is whether lower prices reflect weak demand or have been caused by a surge in the supply of crude.

E. If weak demand is the culprit, that is worrying: it suggests the oil price is a symptom of weakening growth.

F. Indeed, in some countries, cheaper oil may even make matters worse by increasing the risk of deflation.
