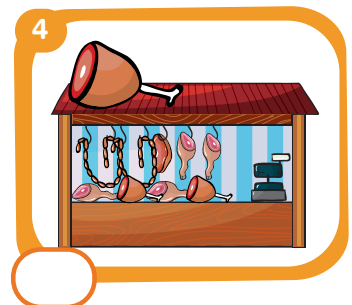
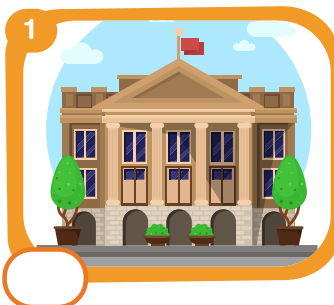

GRAMMAR Expressing purpose and reason.

EXPRESSING PURPOSE

We use **"to- infinitive"** to express the purpose of an action.

examples:

Tom went to the cinema **to** watch an action movie yesterday.

My dad sometimes goes to that butcher's **to** buy meat.

EXPRESSING REASON

We use **"because"** to give the reason for something.

examples:

I must go to the supermarket **because** I need some milk and eggs.

I'm going to sleep early tonight **because** I'm very tired.
