

**accident** • *n.* (kaza) Sam had a traffic **accident** yesterday. He is at hospital now.

**addiction** • *n.* (bağımlılık) Spending too much time on social media is an **addiction**.

**angry** • *adj.* (kızgın, sinirli) My parents get **angry** with me when I spend too much time on the Internet.

**anymore** • *adv.* (artık, bundan böyle) I don't want to see you **anymore**. We don't live in Rome **anymore**.

**application** • *n.* (uygulama) My favorite smartphone **application** is "Google Duo".

**appointment** • *n.* (randevu) I have got an **appointment** with Doctor Smith next Friday at 10 am.

**arrival time** • *n, phr.* (varış zamanı, ulaşma zamanı) This screen shows the departure and **arrival times** of the train.

**as a result** • *conj.* (sonuç olarak) People hunt animals illegally for their fur or meat. **As a result**, most of the species are in danger of extinction.

**available** • *adj.* (müsait, uygun) I'm afraid he is not **available** at the moment.

**average** • *adj.* (ortalama) The **average** age of people living in the UK is 40.

**awareness** • *n.* (farkındalık) The campaign is trying to raise **awareness** of environmental issues.

**bad line** • *phr.* (bozuk hat, çizirtili hat) I am afraid. I can't hear you well. It is a **bad line**.

**become a reality** • *.* (gerçekleşmek, var olmaya başlamak) My fears have **become a reality**.

**bill** • *n.* (fatura) My father always pays the **bills** online.

**book** • *v.* (rezervasyon yaptırmak) I'd like to **book** a room with a sea view.

**book a room** • *v, phr.* (oda ayırtmak, rezervasyon yapmak) I'd like to **book a room** with a sea view.

**bored** • *adj.* (canı sıkılmış) It was rainy yesterday and Bill couldn't go out, so he felt very **bored**.

**break into** • *phr v.* (hırsızlık için eve girmek) Two burglars **broke into** the old man's house and stole \$10,000.

**burglar** • *n.* (hırsız) The **burglar** broke into my neighbour's house through the living room window.

**buy online** • *phr.* (internetten satın almak) I **bought** a flight ticket **online**.

**call** • *v.* (telefon etmek) I will **call** you tomorrow at 5.

**call back** • *phr v.* (geri aramak, tekrar aramak) Can you tell her to **call** me **back** in an hour?

**call center** • *n, phr.* (çağrı merkezi) Mary works at a **call center**. She answers the customers' questions all day.

**calm down** • *phr v.* (sakin olmak) **Calm down** for a minute and listen to me.

**collect garbage** • *.* (çöp toplamak) The municipality needs the help of many volunteers to **collect garbage** in the parks.

**commander** • *n.* (komutan) They gave a medal to the **commander** for his bravery.

**communicate** • *v.* (haberleşmek, iletişime geçmek) I **communicate** with my high school friends by email regularly.

**communication** • *n.* (iletişim) I prefer face to face **communication**.

**con** • *n.* (olumsuz yanı) We discussed the pros and **cons** of living in a big city.

**confirm** • *v.* (doğrulamak, tasdik etmek, onaylamak) Please **confirm** your email address and password.

**connect** • *v.* (bağlamak, bağlantı kurmak, iletişim sağlamak) Could you please **connect** me to the manager?

**contact** • *n, v.* (irtibat kurmak, iletişime geçmek, iletişim) I am always in **contact** with my friends from high school. If you have a problem with the internet connection, **contact** your service provider.

**contribute** • *v.* (katkıda bulunmak) The new discovery will **contribute** a lot to different fields of science.

**cool** • *adj.* (çok iyi, harika, güzel) Their new house is really **cool**.

**cost** • *n, v.* (mal olmak, ücret tutmak maliyet) How much does it **cost** to buy a new smartphone? The **cost** of our holiday was about two thousand dollars.

**crazy** • *adj.* (çılgın, deli) I think our new neighbours are a bit **crazy**.

**customer service** • *n, phr.* (müşteri hizmetleri) You can contact **Customer Service** when you have a problem with the product. The **customer service** is available 7 days a week.

**decision** • *n.* (karar) It was a difficult **decision** to make.

**deliver** • *v.* (dağıtmak, teslim etmek) The post office **delivers** the letters only on Mondays.

**delivery** • *n.* (teslimat, dağıtım) The post office has no **delivery** to the area on Wednesdays.

**departure** • *n.* (kalkış, ayrılış) Could you change the **departure** date for this ticket?

**destination** • *n.* (gidilecek yer, varış yeri) Rome is the most popular tourist **destination** in Italy.

**development** • *n.* (ilerleme, gelişme) Countries spend millions of dollars on research and **development**.

**dial** • *v.* (telefon numarası çevirmek, aramak) Could you **dial** the doctor's number for me? **Dial** 112 and ask for an ambulance.

**disabled** • *adj.* (engelli) Jane always helps **disabled** people.

**distant** • *adj.* (uzak, mesafeli) The village is about ten kilometres **distant** from the city.

**disturb concentration** • *phr.* (rahatsız etmek, dikkatini dağıtmak) The children in the garden are **disturbing my concentration**, so I can't study here.

**donate** • *v.* (bağışlamak, hibe etmek) Mike is always generous to poor people. He regularly **donates** money to the charity.

**doorbell** • *n.* (kapı zili) Listen! Someone is ringing the **doorbell**.

**driving licence** • *n, phr.* (sürücü belgesi) You need a **driving licence** to drive a car.

**ease** • *n.* (rahatlık, kolaylık) He passed his English exam with **ease**.

**educative** • *adj.* (eğitici) I think documentaries are really **educative**.

**embarrassed** • *adj.* (utanmış) Mary fell down in front of the people and felt so **embarrassed**.

**emergency number** • *n, phr.* (acil çağrı numarası) Call the **emergency number** and ask for an ambulance.

**emoticon** • *n.* (yüz ifadelerini belirten simge) I always express my feelings with **emoticons** while texting messages.

**engaged** • *adj.* (meşgul (telefon)) The line is **engaged**. I can't get through. I called you last night, but the phone was **engaged**.

**environment** • *n.* (çevre) We have to keep our **environment** clean and safe. Chemicals have damaging effects on the **environment**.

**essential** • *adj.* (önemli, hayati) Computers have become an **essential** part of modern life.

**evolve** • *v.* (gelişmek, değişmek) The company has **evolved into** one of the world's largest technology companies.

**extension** • *n.* (dahili telefon hattı) Could you put me through to **extension** 210?

**face** • *v.* (yüzleşmek, yüz yüze gelmek) In the future, we are going to **face** with serious problems.

**faculty of medicine** • *.* (Tıp fakültesi) My brother studies at the **faculty of medicine**. He wants to be a doctor.

**fire** • *n.* (yangın) If you see a big **fire**, you should call the fire department. The **fire** caused serious damage to the museum.

**flight reservation** • *n, phr.* (uçuş rezervasyonu) Hi. I'd like to confirm my **flight reservation**.

**flight ticket** • *n, phr.* (uçuş bileti) I booked my **flight ticket** last week.

**for the sake of** • *phr.* (uğruna, yararına) We should stop using chemicals **for the sake of** saving our planet.

**foreign** • *adj.* (yabancı, yurt dışı kaynaklı) My brother is interested in learning **foreign** languages.

**generation** • *n.* (nesil, kuşak) The older **generation** watches TV and listens to classical music a lot.

**get angry** • *phr.* (kızmak, sinirlenmek) My father **got angry** with me when I broke the kitchen's window.

**get back** • *phr v.* (geri gelmek, dönmek) I hope I will **get back** home before dinner.

**get married** • *v, phr.* (evlenmek) Aunt Jane is going to **get married** next month. Albert Einstein **got married** to Mileva Maric in 1903.

**go on** • *phr v.* (devam etmek) I will **go on** working until 3 am.

**goldsmith** • *n.* (kuyumcu) The **goldsmith** gave her a golden chain as a present.

**graduate** • *v.* (mezun olmak) What are you planning to do after you **graduate** from university?

**guess** • *v.* (tahmin etmek) I **guess** he will be a famous scientist in the future. I **guess** the food you love eating most is pizza.

**guy** • *n.* (adam, herif) The new boss is a really nice **guy**.

**hang on** • *phr v.* ((telefonda) kısa süre beklemek) **Hang on** a minute. I'll get Tom.

**hang up** • *phr v.* (telefonu kapamak) Kate always says goodbye before she **hangs up** the phone.

**happy** • *adj.* (mutlu) I am **happy** to see you again.

**harmful** • *adj.* (zararlı) Some drugs can have **harmful** side-effects.

**have an operation** • *phr.* (operasyon geçirmek, ameliyat olmak) The doctor at the hospital says I must **have an operation** at once.

**headmaster** • *n.* (müdür) I must go and see the **headmaster** at once.

**homeless** • *adj.* (evsiz, yurtsuz) Hundreds of people were **homeless** after the earthquake.

**idea** • *n.* (öneri, fikir) The barbeque party was Linda's **idea**.

**improve** • *v.* (geliş(tir)mek, iyileş(tir)mek) She wants to **improve** her English before she goes to England.

**in need** • *adj, phr.* (muhtaç, ihtiyacı olan) We should help people **in need**. The area is **in need** of more support from the government.

**incident** • *n.* (olay, hadise) She doesn't remember anything about the **incident**.

**interaction** • *n.* (etkileşim) There's not enough **interaction** between the teacher and the students.

**internet connection** • *n, phr.* (internet bağlantısı) If you have a slow **internet connection**, you should contact your service provider. I think I have a problem with my **internet connection**.

**invent** • v. (icat etmek) Alan Turing **invented** the first computer in 1936. Philo Taylor Farnsworth, a 21-year-old boy **invented** the world's first electronic television in 1927.

**issue** • n. (konu, mevzu) Teenagers aren't interested in environmental **issues**.

**joke** • n. (şaka, fıkra) My grandpa is very funny. He's really good at telling **jokes**.

**keep in touch** • v, phr. (iletişimi koparmamak, irtibat halinde olmak) I use social networking sites to **keep in touch** with my friends. Sue and I never **kept in touch** after university.

**latest** • adj. (en son, yepyeni) I watch the **latest** video clips on YouTube.

**leave a message** • v, phr. (mesaj bırakmak) Would you like to **leave a message**? I **left a message** when I couldn't find him in his office.

**local authority** • n. (yerel yönetimde idareci, mülki idare amiri) **Local authorities** are planning to close the library.

**loud** • adj. (yüksek sesli) I can't study because my brother is making a **loud** noise.

**make a complaint** • phr. (şikayette bulunmak) I am going to **make a complaint** to the police about the noise.

**make a phone call** • phr. (telefonla aramak) I need to **make a phone call** before I leave the office.

**make sense** • phr. (anlam ifade etmek, mantıklı gelmek) That graph doesn't **make sense** for me.

**matter** • n. (sorun, problem) You look worried. What is the **matter**?

**medical care** • n, phr. (tıbbi tedavi, tıbbi bakım) My grandfather is getting good **medical care** at this hospital.

**meet up** • phr v. (toplanmak, buluşmak) I **meet up** with Linda to play chess once a week.

**memo** • n. (kısa not, hatırlatıcı) I wrote a **memo** to the manager about the meeting.

**misunderstanding** • n. (yanlış anlaşılma) I think there's a **misunderstanding**. I don't want to buy your house.

**mobile telephone** • n, phr. (cep telefonu) Could you tell me your **mobile telephone** number?

**municipality** • n. (belediye) The **municipality** now provides free Wi-Fi in the downtown area.

**neighbour** • n. (komşu) Our new **neighbours** are really noisy. I have really good **neighbours**. They are all kind and friendly.

**neighbourhood** • n. (mahalle) The municipality plans to build a new library in the **neighbourhood**.

**notice** • v. (fark etmek, farkına varmak) I **noticed** a note and a box on my desk.

**officer** • n. (polis memuru) My brother dreams of being an **officer**.

**old-fashioned** • adj. (modası geçmiş) Alice usually wears **old-fashioned** clothes.

**opinion** • n. (fikir, düşünce) What is her **opinion** about a fancy dress party?

**order** • n. (sıralama) She arranged the files in alphabetical **order**.

**own** • v. (sahip olmak) I always want to **own** a house with a big garden by the river.

**participant** • n. (katılımcı, iştirakçi) How many **participants** were there at the meeting?

**percent** • n. (yüzde, hisse) Nearly 80 **percent** of the country is mountainous.

**persecution** • n. (zulüm, eziyet) Muslims have suffered **persecution** for centuries.

**phone** • v. (telefon etmek) Peter's mum **phoned** the doctor because he had a terrible earache.

**pick up the phone** • phr. (telefona cevap vermek, telefonu açmak) I called several times, but no one **picked up the phone**.

**press** • v. (tuşa basmak) **Press** this button to start the washing machine.

**primarily** • adv. (öncelikle, ilk olarak, başlıca) I am **primarily** interested in the history of English language.

**printing machine** • n, phr. (baskı makinesi) Johannes Gutenberg invented the first **printing machine** in 1454 in Germany.

**pro** • n. (olumlu yan, destekleyen fikir) We discussed the **pros** and cons of moving to a small town.

**probably** • adv. (muhtemelen, büyük olasılıkla) People will **probably** live on Mars in the future. We will **probably** do everything just by using computers in the future.

**product** • n. (ürün) Cheese and butter are **products** made from milk.

**provide** • v. (sağlamak, temin etmek) Forests **provide** oxygen for us.

**purpose** • n. (amaç, gaye) The **purpose** of the research is to find out more about the usage of the Internet among teenagers.

**put someone through** • phr v. ((telefon) bağlamak) Could you **put me through** to Mrs White, please?

**put through** • phr v. (telefonda bağlamak, telefonu aktarmak) Could you **put me through** to the manager, please?

**raise** • v. (1. artırmak, çoğaltmak 2. toplamak (para)) They are trying to **raise** awareness about the environment.

**range** • n. (yayılma alanı, menzil) The **range** of the first radio was about only one mile. Electric cars today have a **range** of up to 350 miles.



**rank** • v. (sıraya koymak, derecelendirme yapmak) People **rank** her among the best writer's of the country.

**reach** • v. (ulaşmak, varmak) Walk straight ahead until you **reach** the museum.

**rebuild** • v. (düzeltmek, eski haline getirmek) He had difficulty in **rebuilding** his life after coming out of prison.

**refugee** • n. (sığınmacı, mülteci) He donated some money to help **refugees**.

**report** • v. (bilgi vermek, açıklamada bulunmak) You should **report** the incident to the local authorities.

**rescue** • v. (kurtarmak) The firefighters **rescued** the little girl from a burning building. Nasa sent a space shuttle to **rescue** the astronauts on Mars.

**reservation** • n. (rezervasyon, yer ayırtma) I made a **reservation** for us at the restaurant.

**reserve** • v. (rezervasyon yapmak) I'd like to **reserve** a table for two.

**response** • n. (cevap, yanıt) I am waiting for Kevin's **response** to my invitation.

**return** • v. (1. iade etmek, geri vermek; 2. geri dönmek) He **returned** the books to the city library. The astronauts **returned** to the Earth safely.

**return ticket** • n, phr. (gidiş-dönüş bileti) Do you want a single or a **return ticket**?

**ring** • v. ((kapı/telefon) çalmak, telefon etmek) The doorbell is **ringing**. Could you please open the door? George **rang** while you were out.

**safety** • n. (güvenlik) It is important not to give out personal information on the Internet for **safety**. You should wear a helmet for **safety** when you go skateboarding.

**scared** • adj. (korkmuş) Are you **scared** when you see a mouse in the kitchen?

**security** • n. (güvenlik, güvenli olma durumu) Climate change is a serious threat to the **security** of the countries.

**send** • v. (göndermek) Could you **send** me more information by email?

**shooting a movie** • phr. (film çekimi) Monument Valley is a popular **movie shooting** location in the United States.

**single ticket** • n, phr. (gidiş bileti) You can buy a **single ticket** from this ticket machine.

**sleepy** • adj. (uykulu) I felt **sleepy** and went to bed early last night.

**smart** • adj. (1. zeki, akıllı 2. şık) Mark is a **smart** and talented young man.

**smartphone** • n. (akıllı telefon) John bought a new **smart phone**. He uses it for many purposes.

**smiley** • n. (mesajlarda kullanılan gülümseme işareti) Teenagers often use **smileys** in their text messages.

**smoke signal** • n, phr. (duman işareti) The **smoke signal** is one of the oldest forms of communication.

**social network** • n, phr. (sosyal ağ) Which **social network** do you use very often?

**soldier** • n. (asker) **Soldiers** must obey their commanders.

**solve puzzles** • . (bulmaca çözmek) I enjoy **solving puzzles** in my free time.

**staff** • n. (personel, eleman) There is a good relationship between the **staff** and the manager in the company.

**stranger** • n. (yabancı kişi) I saw a **stranger** walking in the garden last night.

**suppose** • v. (varsaymak, düşünmek, farzetmek, sanmak) I **suppose** water shortage will be the biggest problem in the future.

**surprised** • adj. (şaşırmış, şaşkın) I am often **surprised** by how people eat sushi. We were very **surprised** at the news.

**survive** • v. (hayatta kalmak) People can't **survive** without food and water. Only two people **survived** the earthquake.

**talk face to face** • . (yüz yüze görüşmek) **Talking face to face** is the best way of communication.

**telephone line** • . (telefon hattı) The modem is used for connecting a computer to a **telephone line**.

**television transmission** • n, phr. (televizyon yayını) The Eiffel Tower in Paris has a **television transmission** antenna on top.

**terror** • n. (terör) Millions of people left their homes as a result of **terror**.

**text** • n, v. (mesaj; mesaj atmak (cep telefonundan)) I seldom call my friends. I usually **text** them.

**through** • prep. (aracılıyla, vasıtasıyla) Do you connect to the Net **through** your mobile phone?

**tip** • n. (püf noktası, yararlı tavsiye) The book gives very useful **tips** on cooking.

**tool** • n. (alet) My father keeps his **tools** in the garage.

**translate** • v. (çeviri yapmak) Can you help me **translate** this into French?

**travel agent** • n, phr. (seyahat acentası) I booked a flight ticket through the **travel agent**.

**typically** • adv. (tipik olarak, genellikle) The climate here is **typically** rainy.

**urgent** • adj. (acil) There is an **urgent** need for medical supplies and food.

**usage** • n. (kullanım) The **usage** of computers at schools is increasing.

**use** • v. (kullanmak) Can I **use** your phone for a second?

**useful** • adj. (yararlı, faydalı) Nikola Tesla invented many **useful** things. You can find a lot of **useful** information about inventors on the Internet.

**version** • *n.* (versiyon, biçim, model) This is the new **version** of the dictionary.

**video chat** • *n, phr.* (görüntülü konuşma) You can make a **video chat** with your friends on Facebook for free.

**voluntary** • *adj.* (gönüllü) I work for a **voluntary** organization at the weekends.

**war** • *n.* (savaş) I hope there won't be any **wars** between countries in the future.

**warn** • *v.* (uyarmak, ikaz etmek) The authorities **warned** people about the danger of heavy raining.

**warranty** • *n.* (garanti) All of our products are under **warranty**.

**wonder** • *v.* (merak etmek) I really **wonder** what he is doing at the moment.

**worried** • *adj.* (endişeli, kaygılı) I am really **worried** about Jane. How is she today?

**write a letter** • *phr.* (mektup yazmak) I **write a letter** to my aunt once a year.

**write a postcard** • *v, phr.* (kartpostal yazmak) Emily is **writing a postcard** to his family from Paris.

**write down** • *phr v.* (yazmak, not düşmek) Please, **write down** my phone number on the paper.

**yeah** • *adv.* (evet) Are you coming to the party? -**Yeah**.
