

OCCUPATIONS 6th GRADE VOCABULARY

occupation: iş, meslek, uğraşı, meşgale

You have to give your name, age, and occupation on the application form.

job: iş, meslek

Why don't you apply for a part-time job?

name: adını söylemek, saymak

He couldn't name his attacker.

cook: aşçı

John is a very good cook (=he cooks well).

architect: mimar

Jones was the architect of the team's first goal.

nurse: hemşire

She worked as a nurse in a psychiatric hospital.

tailor: terzi

He was a tailor.

lawyer: avukat

I want to see my lawyer before I say anything else.

hairstylist: kuaför, berber

I've got a four o'clock appointment at the hairstylist's.

(traffic) policeman: (trafik) polisi

She went off to fetch a policeman.

engineer: mühendis

You need the advice of a qualified engineer.

mechanic: tamirci, teknisyen

If you smell gas fumes, take the car to your mechanic.

waiter: (erkek) garson

I will ask the waiter for the bill.

speech bubble: konuşma balonu

Fill in the speech bubbles.

cut: kesmek

Cut the meat into small pieces.

sew: dikmek

I need to sew a button on my shirt.

fabric: kumaş, dokuma, bez

My clothes smell of fabric softener.

patient: hasta

The patient has a severe heart condition.

serve: hizmet etmek, servis yapmak, görev yapmak

Serve the cakes warm...

task: iş, görev, vazife

How do you tackle a task like that?

salesperson [salesman/woman]: satıcı, satış yapan kimse

He is an insurance salesperson.

department store: büyük mağaza

I work at that department store.

explain: izah etmek, açıklamak, anlatmak

Can you explain why you did this?

tidy: çeki düzen vermek, düzenlemek, derleyip toplamak

He spent a few minutes tidying his desk.

assist: yardım etmek

The army arrived to assist in the search.

find out: araştırıp ortaya çıkarmak, öğrenmek

I must find out the train times.

manager: yönetici, idareci, âmir

She is the manager of the local sports club.

veterinarian: veteriner, baytar

We took the dog to the local veterinarian.

repair: onarmak, tamir etmek, elden geçirmek

We will need to get someone to repair the roof.

manage: yönetmek, idare etmek

He managed the bookshop on King Street.

grow: (bitki) yetiş[tir]mek, büyü[t]mek

These plants can grow to a height of six feet.

act: rol yapmak, bir film ya da oyunda oynamak

She acted in her first film when she was 13 years old.

look after: bakmak, ilgilenmek, bakımını üstlenmek

Could you look after the children while I'm out?

fight: mücadele etmek, savaşmak, engellemeye çalışmak

He fought against racism.

crime: suç, kabahat, cürüm

He committed a serious crime.

arrest: tutuklamak

The police arrested him in connection with the murder.

criminal: suça ait, suç unsuru taşıyan

He has a criminal record.

typical: karakteristik, tipik

This style of painting is typical of Monet.

change: değiştirmek, değişmek

The course changed my life.

frequently: sık sık [often]

I see him quite frequently.

gym: spor salonu

Nick goes to the gym three times a week.

flight: uçak seyahati, uçuş

Flight 102 is ready for boarding at Gate 3.

date: tarih

Please give your name, address and date of birth.

prepare: hazırlamak

We are preparing the students for their end-of-year exam.

garage: garaj, oto tamirhanesi

I took the car to the local garage to get it fixed.

comb: 1-tarak 2-taramak

Your hair needs a good comb.

rest: dinlenmek, istirahat etmek

Pete is resting after his long drive.

vacuum: elektrik süpürgesiyle temizlemek

Did you vacuum the stairs?

dust: toz almak

I tidied and dusted the shelves.

countryside: kırsal alan, taşra, kır, sayfiye

I dream of living in the countryside.
