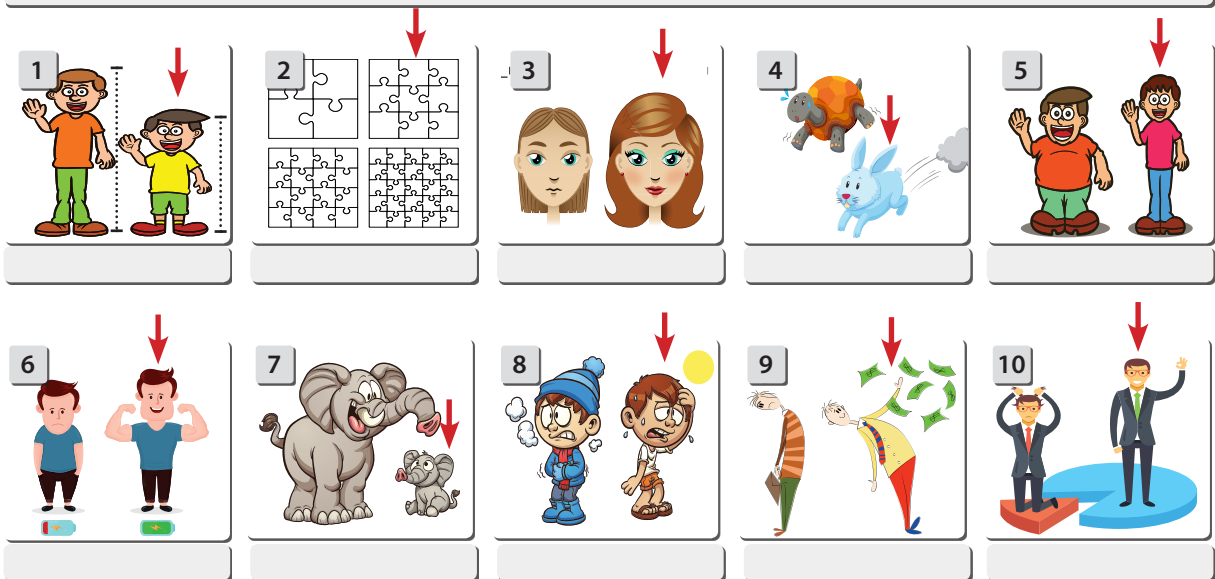

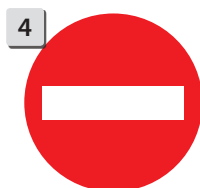

It is a gown in one piece and covers the whole body tightly down to the toes. The creation of the Changshan dates back to 1920s in the city of Shanghai. As time passed by, the middle class and high class Chinese population adopted it as a popular style and fashion item. In the early days of this item, only some social groups and style icons wore it, and today most of the population in China accepts it as the traditional clothing of China.
