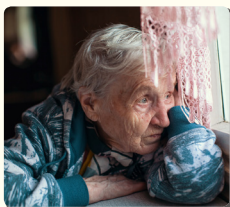

**Loneliness: a big danger to health - Published online, Sunday 8 August 2017**



It is argued that people who are lonely have more **possibility** of dying early. Researchers say that people don't need to be alone at home to feel lonely. *They* supported that people can feel the loneliness even if they are with friends and family etc. Social **isolation** is announced to be another kind of loneliness and they differ from each other. *It* means having lack of **contact with** the people around. That is, when people have this, *they* have no contact with the people near them. People who are with family and friends have less risk of dying early by 50%. Loneliness and social isolation is associated with **severe** health problems, such as Alzheimer's and breast cancer. Everybody would agree that obesity is a very huge problem which **threatens** our health and lifestyles. The researchers even said loneliness might be riskier than *this*!



There is no doubt that old people are worrying about loneliness a lot. *They* should prepare themselves to have social skills for their future life.
